We are pleased to welcome you to the **Pablo de Olavide University**.

This is the information you need in order to become an **EXCHANGE STUDENT** at our university:

1. ACCEPTANCE as Exchange Student:

1.- You need to complete the [online application](#) form. Please follow the steps you will find in the document attached to our registration message.

Please save a copy of your application as a receipt.

2.- We do not need your learning agreement. So please, send it just in case you need it signed by us before your arrival. If you do not need it, we will sign it when you arrive at our institution.

***** IMPORTANT:** the learning agreement can only include a 20% maximum of courses from a Faculty different to yours (i.e. 6 E.C.T.C. maximum by semester). We recommend you to ask your University under which Faculty agreement you are coming.

2. WELCOME MEETINGS

The **information meetings for international students** will take place during the last week of January and there we will give you all relevant information about your stay in Seville. You must choose one of the available dates for the meeting by clicking the chosen date in the application form.

Both meetings will be the same, so you must only attend to one of them. Attendance is **COMPULSORY**.

*** welcome meetings exact dates will be confirmed once the application period will be over.

From the 27th January to 3rd February you must complete your courses enrolment (you will be given further information about how to enrol at the welcome meetings). Afterwards, we will be able to sign your learning agreement, therefore we would be very grateful if you don't send them to us until the course enrolment period is over.

5.- ACCOMMODATION

7. FURTHER INFORMATION

- **Certificate of attendance:** if by the end of your stay, you need us to sign a document stating your stay period in our University, you have to take into account that we will not sign any document with date later than 15th July for the whole year or second semester students.

We recommend you to inform your University about this fact, if necessary, to avoid future problems with your grant.

- Spanish course

Free Spanish course for beginners (maximum two groups of 15 students):

The International Relations Office together with *Centro Universitario Internacional* offers a Spanish course for beginners of 30 hours. Those students who achieve the course goals will receive a course certificate.
