EUrPol has, as previous background, a research area on the analysis and evaluation of urban policies from a comparative perspective in the Urban Governance Lab; a research centre focused on these issues at the Pablo de Olavide University.

### TEACHING

#### Basics for a ‘toolbox’ to understand the urban dimension of European Policies



## TRANSFER AND TRAINING

### Training with EUrPol: providing skills on urban policies to future professionals

#### **Learning about the analysis and evaluation of EU Integrated urban strategies.**

Sociology, Social Work, and Political Science students carried out their curricular internships during the academic year 2021-2022 within the framework of EUrPol. Students have learned theoretical perspectives and methodological tools for the analysis and evaluation of integral and sustainable development projects developed within the framework of the Cohesion Policy, as well as their application to ongoing research projects focused on this topic. Students learn central aspects of the *CUPPA approach (Comparative Urban Portfolio Analysis)* designed by the CSPL and EUrPol to analyse design quality, intervention logic and evaluation of sustainable and integral urban strategies based on the theoretical foundations of these initiatives.

A specific ‘dual learning’ strategy has been designed to carry out this training activity. This strategy designs student activities during traineeship according to the previous analysis of professional competencies and skills about public policies in degree curricula. This learning methodology has been presented in scientific congresses and meetings about teaching methods. A brief description is included in a chapter of the book “*Innovación docente en tiempos de cambio*”.

### **Localising ODS ... in the neighbourhood: practical training on ODS and urban policies research.**

Graduate students, researchers and technical staff of the Urban Governance Lab have developed a specific methodology to study the ODS at the neighbourhood scale. In several training sessions, students have developed a specific methodology to study ODS at the neighbourhood scale. Students have developed and applied this methodology, helped by the EUrPol team and research assistants working on current projects at the Urban Governance Lab. The research strategy aimed to combine secondary data analysis, ethnographical observation and interviews among residents and qualified informants. The methodology has been applied and validated through case studies in three neighbourhoods in Seville where integrated urban strategies promoted by the EU have been implemented.



This initiative has been developed in the framework of the URBAODS projects coordinated by Professor Margarita Barañano (Complutense University of Madrid, UCM). This project, funded as a teaching innovation initiative by the UCM, has involved researchers, graduate and postgraduate students from the


following universities: Complutense de Madrid, Barcelona, São Paulo, Autónoma de México, Buenos Aires and Pablo de Olavide.

## The DUSI URBAN Lab

FAMP and EUrPol have continued to promote the *DUSI Urban Lab* oriented to developing tools to analyse integral and sustainable urban strategies through collaborative research. Three DUSI-Lab workshops have been held during the 2021-22 academic year. Members of the Jean Monnet Chair of Urban Policies in the European Union (EUrPol), the Andalusian Federation of Municipalities and Provinces (FAMP) and Martos, Córdoba, Montilla and Conil de la Frontera and Diputación de Huelva discussed a specific methodology to carry out the strategic analysis of ISUS implementation and evaluation and its application in their urban initiatives.

The work developed in the framework of the DUSI URBAN Lab workshops will be summarised in an online publication, including some of the analytical foundations and methods set to design, implement and evaluate integrated strategies to promote sustainable local development.



### Politiques Urbaines and Toulouse Metropol: learning about integrated strategies at the metropolitan scale.

EURPol and CPFP La Routerie held a seminar on *Politiques Urbaines* in Toulouse and met with *Toulouse Metropol* officials, staff of different initiatives and civic associations involved in integrated projects carried out under the *Politique de la Ville*. Participants shared knowledge and experiences about the practice of integral urban development initiatives at the neighbourhood and urban functional areas scales.

### Cultural policies and sustainable urban development

The EURPol held a seminar about the role of cultural initiatives in promoting sustainable urban development. Professor Marta Klekotko, the Jagiellonian University (Poland), and Clemente J. Navarro, head of EurPol Jean Monnet Chair, made presentations focused on answering the following questions: *What role does culture play in promoting sustainable urban development? What role does it play and can it play in the sustainable urban development policies promoted by the European Union?*. This seminar is one of the activities carried out by Professor Klekotko during her stay at the Urban Governance Lab with the aim of establishing comparative research strategies on the impact of cultural initiatives on sustainable urban development through the integrated urban approach promoted by the European Union in the framework of the international network on 'Cultural Scenes and Urban Development' promoted by the RC03 of the International Sociological Association. Marta Klekotko and Clemente J. Navarro are vice-president and president of this research committee. A collaborative project proposal was prepared about the research topic of the seminar.

## The effects of place-based urban policies: European and Latin American perspectives

Promoted by EUrPol, researchers from the Gino Germani Institute and The Urban Governance Lab participated in a seminar discussing theoretical and methodological approaches for the comparative analysis of integrated area-based policies in Europe and Latin America. Mercedes Najman, a CONICET researcher and head of the Urban Studies Area of the Gino Germani Institute of the University of Buenos Aires (IIGG), has presented the theoretical framework and results based on the research she is developing on this subject. This seminar is one of the activities carried out by Professor Najman during her stay at the Urban Governance Lab to develop comparative works between policies promoted by the European Union studied by EUrPol and those implemented in the Latin American context analysed by IIGG.
