Description of the organisation

The University of Siena dates back to 1240, when a tradition of teaching and research was established in one of the most fluorescent free towns of Middle Age's Italy located on the path of the pilgrims' Via Francigena. Since then, the European culture, the attraction of international scholars and the respect of academic freedom have been cultivated within our university, which is therefore one of the oldest Higher Education Institutions in Europe. Today, USiena counts over 18.000 students, enrolled in a broad range of degree courses. 71 are the programs activated for the academic year 2020-2021 They include Bachelor courses (3 years), Master courses (2 years) and Long Cycle degree Courses (5 to 6 years). Moreover, 23 three-year Doctoral programs are offered, together with a number of shorter vocational post-graduate programs. According to the most important Italian University ranking (CENSIS- LA Repubblica), during the last five years, USiena has always ranked among the best 3 medium-sized Italian Universities, with remarkable grades for study grants and services for students. The Times Higher Education World University Rankings considered USiena in a position between 401 and 500, and the reputation of USiena has recently grown according to a number of other specialist rankings

These figures report the effects of an internationalisation strategy that has been enhanced over the years. The current challenge is the consolidation of this strategy. Uni Siena aims to become not only a leading teaching and research institution in Europe, but also a truly global university capable of welcoming an increasing number of international students. Over 10% of Uni Siena's students recruited in the last three years have come from abroad, and the recent establishment of a number of teaching programmes offered entirely in English will help to increase this trend.

The degree courses currently taught in English are: two three-year degree courses (Economics and Banking; Economics and Business), a long cycle course (Dentistry and dental Prosthodontics), 15 Master's degree courses (Applied Mathematics, Artificial Intelligence and Automation Engineering, Biodiversity and Environmental health, Biotechnologies of Human Reproduction, Chemistry, Economics, Electronics and Communication Engineering, Engineering Management, Finance, Genetic Counsellors, Medical Biotechnologies, European Studies; International Accounting and Management, Public and Culture Diplomacy, Language and Mind, Sustainable Industrial Pharmaceutical Biotechnology).

The recent establishment of a number of double degrees, the increasing mobility of students (both for studies and internships), staff and faculty, and the active participation in a number of important international higher education networks (including Coimbra Group, European University Association, Magna Charta Observatory, UNIMED and Copernicus Alliance, Scholar At Risks) represent further relevant actions in our internationalisation strategy.

Some general figures illustrate the international links between Uni Siena and the global dimension:

- more than 400 active Erasmus partnerships;

- more than 500 Erasmus mobility grants for outgoing students and trainees per year;

- more than 800 incoming students and staff per year;
- more than 250 partnerships with universities in Europe, Africa, Latin America, Canada, Russia, Japan, the Middle East, the USA and Vietnam;
- 72 foreign universities involved in international doctoral programmes;
- more than 20 foreign universities involved in Master's programmes.

According to its current internationalisation strategy, the University of Siena will not only increase



the percentage of non-Italian students in all courses offered by its 15 departments. It is, in fact, planning to increase links with high-level higher education institutions from Europe, North America and Asia. In addition, a number of cooperation activities have recently been launched in Africa and Latin America. We are working on a number of new internationalisation tools: a new international registration system, new services for international students and a new strategic webbased communication plan called 'International Faculty', designed to increase the quality and number of visiting researchers and adjunct professors. At the same time, the Uni Siena community is working on an extensive cooperation plan to increase partnerships with foreign countries. The inclusion of Africa, the Far East, Japan and Latin America is a crucial step in this new plan, which includes research partnerships, short-term student and staff mobility projects, Uni Siena summer schools abroad and other actions.

Specifically, the Department of Social, Political and Cognitive Sciences (DISPOC) of the University of Siena gathers researchers and professors from different disciplinary areas. It has a strong disciplinary and methodological pluralism in both teaching and research.

It has 60 academic staff members (professors and researchers) and more than 2000 students enrolled in 4 degree courses, 7 master's degree courses and 1 doctoral programme. Both teaching staff and students are highly motivated to enrich their teaching and learning experiences also through international exchanges. Internationalisation is a top priority and lecturers are committed to enhancing international activities in order to improve higher education provision for Italian and foreign students.

At the Department of 'Education, Humanities and Intercultural Communication' there is an Inclusion Point dedicated to students with learning disorders (DSA) or disabilities. Inspired by the principles of the right to study, independent living, active citizenship and full inclusion within the university community, the Centre for Inclusion (<u>https://www.unisi.it/ateneo/lavorare-unisi/accoglienza-disabili-e-servizi-dsa</u>) offers specific services to support the academic career of all those who request them:

- Welcome interview: to identify the most suitable support, based on the type of disability or DSA;
- Office support: useful for managing any criticalities that may arise during the course of study and for fostering relations with other University structures;
- Accompaniment: transport and accompaniment service in cases of reduced mobility;
- Assistance: in the classroom for seminars, conferences, supplementary lessons, lunch breaks, etc.;
- Tutoring: in the event of particular difficulties in exam preparation or thesis writing, support is provided by student tutors. The service is only provided on demand, following customisation criteria based on a careful analysis of specific training needs;
- On-going guidance service: support service for the achievement of study objectives;
- Technological aids: there are specific technological tools for attending lessons or taking examinations (laptops, voice synthesis software, digital recorders), teaching materials in alternative formats (digital, large print, Braille) and for language mediation (sign language interpretation and stenotyping);
- Examination methods and tests: at the request of students and/or the teacher, support and advice is provided in order to identify suitable methods for each individual case (such as: additional time, equivalent tests, technical aids and tools, presence of communication assistants, etc.).

Experience and Expertise of the organization in the project's subject area



The University of Siena also has a dedicated service for students with disabilities and DSA. The offices support students with disabilities and SLD - **Specific Learning Disorders** in academic career and international mobility procedures. They manage requests for aids, compensatory and dispensatory tools for examinations and tests for access to courses, accessible teaching materials and digitised texts. They manage relations with teachers and the CLA for the definition of examination procedures. They coordinate the activities of the student tutors, part-time collaborators and the young people involved in the civil service project for disability and DSA. They coordinate all the activities of the VAI Laboratory and plan the accompanying and transport service and the LIS interpreting service for deaf students.

The disability and LSD sector of the University of Siena (<u>https://www.unisi.it/disabili-dsa</u>) offers a series of services to students with disabilities and DSA throughout their university career, from enrolment, to course attendance, to the first approach to the world of work after graduation (<u>https://orientarsi.unisi.it/studio/struttura/settore-disabilita-e-dsa</u>)

The university offers specific services for students with disabilities, including: reception, accompaniment, assistance and aids for examinations and admission tests, classroom assistance, accessible and personalised examinations, LIS interpretation, material in accessible format, support for the completion of administrative procedures, for dealing with other structures of the university and with the DSU, specialised tutoring to support study.

The University of Siena promotes accessible didactics: didactic support is aimed at all students with special needs and requirements. The service includes a series of activities aimed at guaranteeing equal opportunities in all aspects of university life.

Specialised tutoring is personalised study support provided by students or volunteers from the civil service, specially selected and trained on the basis of specific skills, who accompany students in building their personal autonomy. After assessing needs and availability, the tutor is assigned and a weekly study programme is defined. In particular, the tutor supports the students:

-in the preparation of examinations

-in bibliographical research and thesis writing;

-in improving the study method by learning reading software and specific tools.

In order to enable everyone to attend lectures, seminars and teaching activities, it is also possible to request an adaptation of the lecturer's teaching, i.e. different tools or teaching methods can be requested according to personal needs. The most common adaptations are for example:

-audio recording of lectures;

-handouts and slides in hard copy or digital in advance;

-use of interactive whiteboard (interactive whiteboard);

-ability to request an accessible classroom;

-Tutor support during the lesson;

-support in the classroom by LIS interpreter;

-accessible table or desk in the classroom

The University also offers a mediation service with lecturers to define adaptations for laboratory tests, examinations, admission or graduation tests. It is possible to agree on any measures that need to be taken to ensure that the student's preparation is evaluated equally. Each request is assessed individually, taking into account the lecturer's instructions. Adaptations may be (by way of example):

-definition of a customised examination programme; -adaptation of the examination mode (written/oral, open/multiple answer); -support from a tutor for assistance with reading and writing;



-presence of a LIS interpreter; -increased time available; -division of the examination into several parts; -use of technological aids.

This is complemented by a LIS interpreting service is a language mediation service offered to all deaf students who know the Italian Sign Language (LIS), which is carried out through professional LIS interpreters who assist the student during activities such as:

-attending lessons in the classroom;

-holding examinations;

-holding interviews with teachers;

-participating in seminars and all the activities envisaged in the teaching plan.

Students with SLD who need teaching materials in a format other than paper may request alternative format texts such as: books in audio format, when available, or handouts or notes recorded by the tutors; examination texts and handouts in digital format (TxT, DOC, PDF) for study with speech synthesis programmes.

Contributions that can be provided to the project

The University of Siena's request to join the partnership is determined by the project's scientific head, Prof. Maria Rita Mancaniello, who has specific competences and national recognition in the field of university policies and inclusion processes. It is believed that her scientific and research value is fundamental for the project and its development and to guarantee the project's objectives. The University of Siena has the skills, facilities and services to guarantee the success of the project.

Reasons of involvement in the project

The request for the entry of the University of Siena is determined by the scientific coordinator, in the person of Prof. Maria Rita Mancaniello, and it is requested that she can remain the project leader. The University of Florence has asked to be included as an Associate Partner, in order to allow the research team of the University of Florence to participate in the subsequent project actions with the professors already involved until February 2023. The tasks of the University of Siena will thus be the same as those carried out to date by the University of Florence.

Research Areas

Her main research area - deepened, experimented and consolidated, over the years, through theoretical studies and field works in the local and international cooperation - focuses on the transdisciplinary model of educational processes. This model is studied in its epistemological and scientific basis and in its strategic and methodological options, aimed towards the transdisciplinary science of education in the historical transition towards the Terrestrial Humanism of a Sustainable Civilization. This model is based on the complex theory of potential of the sensory-motor, emotional and rational knowledge and it is directed to develop creative processes of individual social and cultural advanced intelligences, related to the intangible and tangible qualitative co-growth of the communities in the territories, mostly for the most deprived groups and subjects. The model is experimented in the scientific and professional work on Complex Human Development, Creating Knowledge Paradigms beyond violence, Transdisciplinary Participatory Action Research, Lifelong Learning Strategies, Politics and Institutions of formal, non-formal and informal Education. The operational framework is the Network of Community Education, in the wider context of Local and Global Development for quality of environmental, social and individual life.

During the last years, an important focus of analysis has been concentrated on the levels of reality that are developed, today, in a technologically advanced society and on the way for developing the potential for learning immersed in virtual and augmented reality.
