PRACTICAL INFO

Getting to Sevilla

- **By plane**

If you decide to fly to Seville, you'll land at the Seville Airport, located 9 kilometres east of Seville. You can get to the centre of Seville from the airport in just 15 minutes if you use your own car, rent a car or take a taxi, Uber or Cabify. And it will take just 35 minutes if you choose the bus.

- **By train (Santa Justa Station)**

You can reach Santa Justa Station on high-speed lines from Cordoba, Madrid, Zaragoza and Barcelona on the southwest-northeast line of the AVE, and from Malaga on the AVANT trains. The terminal's location is just a 15-minute walk from the city centre. Tickets are available online <https://www.renfe.com>

- **By car**

Seville is perfectly connected by road. A highway network connects it with all areas: the A-49 links it with Huelva and Portugal. The A-92 links to Malaga and Granada. The A-4 arrives from Cordoba and Madrid. The A-66 connects to Extremadura and the north of Spain.

The SE-30, the Ronda Super Norte and the SE-40 are the bypass roads facilitating movement around the city and its metropolitan area.

Getting to UPO

The University of Pablo de Olavide is located at km. 1 on the highway from Sevilla to Utrera, close to many transport links.

- **By Metro** (<http://www.metro-sevilla.es/es/>): Line 1 stops at the University of Pablo de Olavide. You can take the subway from different stations and pay directly at the turnstile using your credit card. There is a 5-minute walk from Pablo de Olavide metro station to the meeting location (Building 45).
- **By Bus** (<https://www.tussam.es/>): Bus lines 38, M-130A and M-130B link the city to the University Pablo de Olavide. The bus company also offers a smartphone platform: <https://www.tussam.es/es/descarga-app>. Bus tickets are available from the driver (from 1.40 euros) or vending machines at Metrocentro stops.
- **By Car**: Reach Seville's SE30 ring road and follow indications SE30 direction GRANADA; exit SE30 following indications to UTRERA; then take the second exit from Carretera de Utrera towards UNIVERSIDAD PABLO OLAVIDE.

WORKSHOP LOCATION

Activities will take place in Building 45 “Alexander von Humboldt” (room B11), 5 min. walking from the Metro station in the campus. See map below.



The **wi-fi connection** is provided through the Eduroam network. Participants from non-European institutions will be provided with user and password for connecting in the campus.

Accommodation

Our first recommendation is that you book a room at [LIV Student Sevilla](#) a very modern and well located student residence, 5 minutes walking to Metro Station San Bernardo, and 20 minutes walking to the historical centre.
