Basic Covid-19 regulations

As Andalucía currently has a very low 14 day incidence rate (under 50 per 100,000 people as of October 2021), all universities have returned to in-person classes.

However, the following rules apply while on UPO's campus:

- You **must** wear a **face mask** on campus **at all times** when inside buildings. This is true everywhere in Spain.
- Maintain a distance of 1.5 meters between people (who do not live together) at all times when outside and not wearing a face mask.
- Practice adequate hygiene and frequent hand washing.
- Practice proper **respiratory etiquette** (sneezing or coughing into your elbow or a tissue).
- Crowds should be avoided and building and classroom entrances should be kept clear, maintaining the 1.5 meter distancing at all times.
- Do NOT come to campus if you present any symptoms of Covid-19 or if you are in quarantine for any reason. In this case, you must contact the International Office: 95-497-73-00.

If you have Covid-19 symptoms (fever, cough, trouble breathing, etc.), you must stay at home and refer to the "What to do if you experience Covid-19 symptoms" guide on our website (www.upo.es/intl under "Covid-19 News").
