## ABOUT PABLO DE OLAVIDE UNIVERSITY

Pablo de Olavide University, one of Spain's youngest and smallest public universities, is a dynamic and modern university founded in 1997. The University has a population of over 13,000 students and offers both undergraduate and graduate programs in a variety of academic fields.

UPO is located on a beautiful 345 acre campus less than 5 miles from Seville's city center. In addition to the many classroom buildings, a library, computer and science laboratories, a dining hall and two cafeterias, the campus contains a gym, padel tennis courts, indoor basketball and soccer courts, an outdoor running track and playing fields. Seville's metro was inaugurated in April of 2009 and its first line links the University with the city center. A bike path also links the University to many parts of Seville.

#### **SEVILLE**

Seville is Spain's fourth largest city and the capital of Andalusia. It is a city rich in history, cultural traditions and art. Its Moorish palaces, narrow cobblestoned streets and beautiful gardens remind the visitor of centuries past. # **SEMESTER PROGRAMS**

# **MULTIDISCIPLINARY STUDIES PROGRAM**

The Multidisciplinary Studies program offers semester-long courses taught both in Spanish and in English in areas such as art, business, economics, history, political science and many others. Spanish language courses are offered at six levels and include classes such as business Spanish, conversation, phonetics, reading & composition and translation.

Students enrolled in the Interdisciplinary Studies Program may take up to 5 classes which corresponds to 15 US credits (30 ECTS credits )

A minimum G.P.A. of 2.75 (on a 4.0 scale) is required in order to participate in the Multidisciplinary Studies Program.

#### **HOST FAMILIES**

The International Center offers lodging with Spanish host families with full board. The Center feels that this is the best way to learn about Spanish culture and traditions and practice and improve language skills.

#### ¿How is the family?

The family can be a couple with or without children or a woman with or without children. Some families have other students, either Spaniards or foreigners, but only Spanish is spoken at home. You can easily make friends with the other students living in the home.

#### Room

The student can choose a single room or a double room to share with another student. We always try to respect your choice but everything depends on availability. The host family provides you with sheets and towels so you only need to bring personal belongings. Laundry services once or twice a week are also included.

## **UNIVERSITY INTEGRATION PROGRAM (PIU)**

The University Integration Program (PIU) is especially designed for students with highly advanced Spanish language skills who wish to integrate themselves fully into a Spanish university by enrolling directly in regular classes with Spanish students. Furthermore, for students who are business majors but are not fluent in Spanish, there are a number of business courses available in English with Spanish students as well.
