The journal is presented as an open and plural academic forum that allows researchers from different backgrounds and disciplines to establish a fruitful exchange of the state-of-the-art scientific advances in this field of study.

Researchers and professionals working in any academic discipline related to Sephardic studies may publish in this magazine: Linguistics, Literature, History, Musicology, Digital Humanities, Folklore, Social and Human Sciences, Codicology, etc. Articles must be original, unpublished, and relevant and may not have been presented simultaneously in any other publication.

Meldar: Revista internacional de estudios sefardíes will accept for publication papers referring to the different areas of Sephardic studies, as well as reviews of works on this subject.

The manuscripts must be written in Spanish or English.

The maximum length of the article will be 80,000 characters (with spaces), while the length of the reviews will be between 6,000 and 8,000 characters (with spaces).

Meldar: Revista internacional de estudios sefardíes does not charge fees for submission of papers, nor for the publication of articles.

The reception of originals is open throughout the year. Nevertheless, after September 15th, the editorial team cannot guarantee the inclusion of the proposal in the current issue.

We then kindly make a call for Sephardi researchers and professionals to submit their articles and reviews for the third issue of *Meldar: Revista internacional de estudios sefardíes* due in December 2022.
